STUDENT SUCCESS STORY

From taking the first step to finding her confidence



A Passion for Learning

For Shuyan, learning has always been a part of her journey. With a background in teaching and experience working in schools across China, Canada and Australia, she has always enjoyed discovering new skills and knowledge.

That passion brought her to Parramatta Community College, where she found practical courses that allowed her to explore new areas and continue growing. What began with one course soon became a much bigger journey. Shuyan has now completed five courses at PCC.

“ I always enjoy learning. I think PCC provides the practical courses which give us different skills and knowledge. ”

When Learning Gets Challenging

Shuyan's journey hasn't always been easy. Some courses introduced concepts that were completely new to her, and there were moments when the challenge felt overwhelming.

“There were times when I had the idea of giving up,” she recalls.

Instead of walking away, Shuyan stopped and asked herself an important question: Why did I apply for this course in the first place? And how can I overcome this difficulty?

Her answer was to keep moving forward, one step at a time.

“ Each progress, even small progress, is still progress. So I just take steps to go on studying. ”

That mindset became one of the most important lessons of her journey: progress doesn't have to be big to matter.

Finding Confidence Along the Way

Through her studies, Shuyan gained more than practical skills. She discovered a growing sense of confidence.

When she first started her Makeup Artistry & Client Care course, she was uncomfortable having photos and videos taken. Over time, she stepped outside her comfort zone and became more confident sharing her work.

Today, she is sitting in front of the camera sharing her own story, hoping that her experience can encourage others to take their own first step.

Her trainer, Lisa, also noticed how Shuyan's confidence grew throughout her time at PCC, describing her as someone who now encourages and inspires others in class.

More Than a Course

For Shuyan, Parramatta Community College has become more than a place to study. It has become a supportive community where she feels comfortable, encouraged and connected to others.

The skills she gained have strengthened her confidence and opened her mind to new career possibilities. Just as importantly, she has become someone who encourages other students when they face their own challenges.

“ PCC is a great place for us to study because it makes students feel comfortable, positive and encouraged. I've also made a lot of progress becoming more and more confident. ”

Her message to future students is simple: **take the first step**. You don't have to know exactly where the journey will lead. Sometimes, you just need to start – and keep going, one small step at a time.

STUDY SMARTER, NOT HARDER

Simple tips to help you stay on track with your studies

1

Plan your week

Take 10 minutes at the start of each week to write down your classes, work commitments, assessments and personal activities. Knowing what's ahead makes it easier to stay organised.



2

Break big tasks into smaller steps

Don't wait until the night before an assessment or exam. Break the task into smaller steps—like research, note-taking, drafting and reviewing—and tackle them one at a time.



3

Set aside dedicated study time

Choose a regular time each week for study and treat it like an appointment. Even a few focused sessions can help you stay on top of your coursework.



4

Ask questions early

Not sure about an assessment or something covered in class? Ask your trainer or support team rather than waiting until you're stuck.



5

Keep your study materials organised

Create folders for each subject and keep your notes, assessments and resources together. A little organisation can save you a lot of time later.



6

Give yourself a break

Study is important, but so is rest. Make time for sleep, meals, movement and the people and activities you enjoy.



You don't have to do everything at once. Small, consistent steps can help you make steady progress.

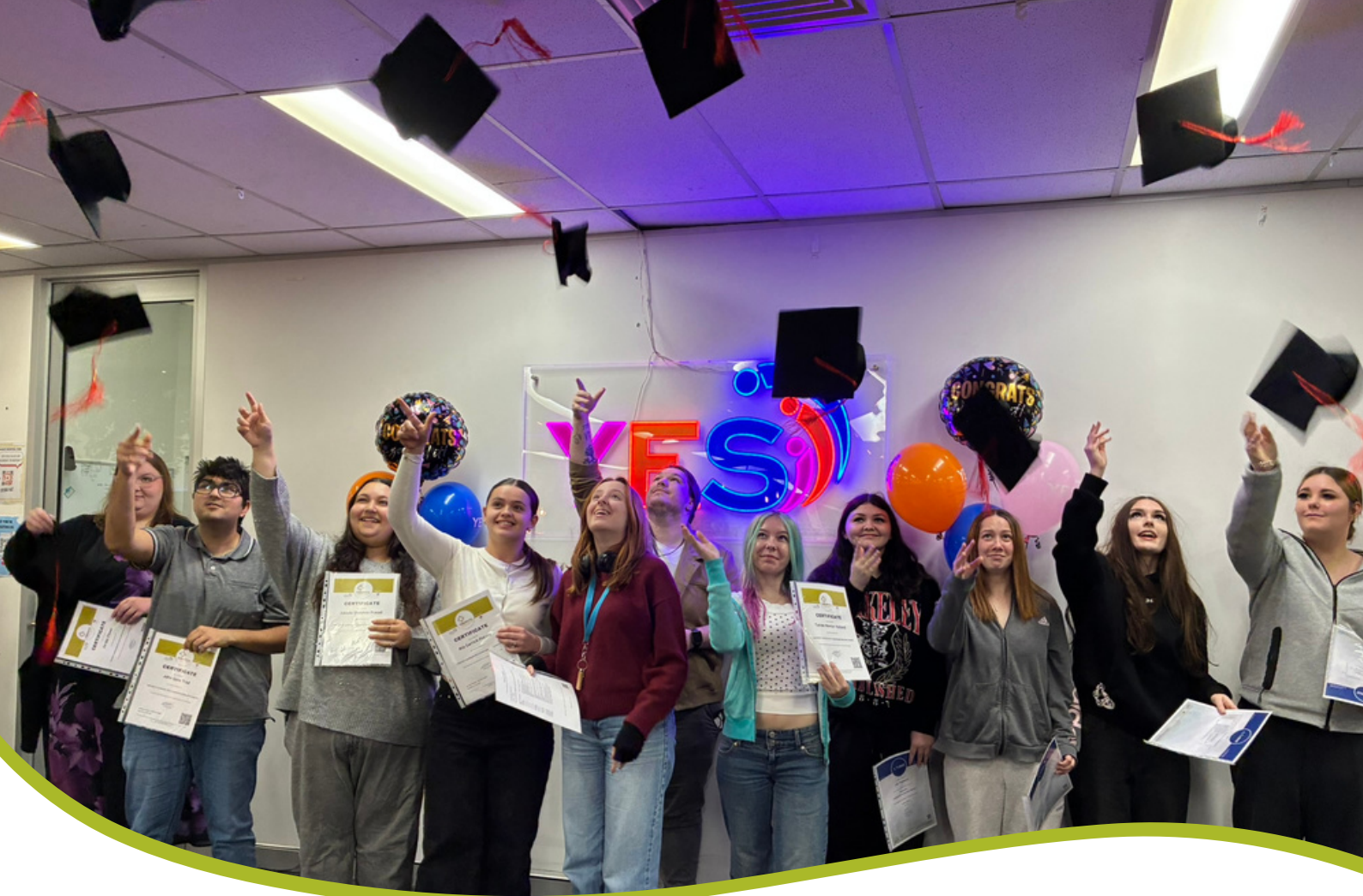
